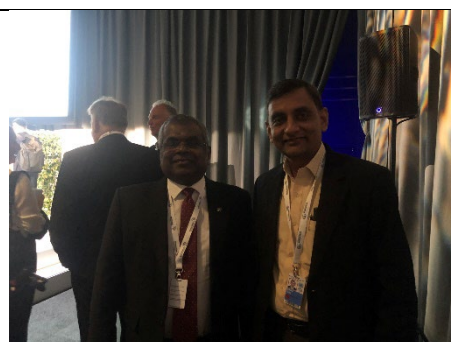
The United Nations General Assembly, by its resolution 75/280 of 24 May 2021, decided to convene an international meeting in Stockholm on 2 and 3 June 2022 to commemorate the 50-year anniversary of the holding of the United Nations Conference on the Human Environment, 1972. The General Assembly agreed on the theme of “Stockholm+50: a healthy planet for the prosperity of all – our responsibility, our opportunity” and decided to organize collaborative and multi-stakeholder leadership dialogues.

During the meeting, I attended various sessions starting from the Commemorative Moment, Plenary Meetings / Sessions, Leadership Dialogues, Side Events (such as Waste Management: Mayor’s dialogue on targeting Zero Waste, A dialogue with UN Heads of Agencies, Action towards Marine Plastic Pollution for Implementation of Sustainable Development Goals etc.) as well as Action Hub Events (such as Using the clothes we love to protect the nature we need, Data Driven Environmental Solutions Hub etc.) which fall in the areas of interest to me till the Final Plenary and Concluding Session.

Also, during the event I met various Heads of Country Delegations such as Mr. John Kerry, an American attorney, politician, diplomat and the first United States special presidential envoy for climate, Dr. Abdulla Naseer, Minister of State for Environment, Government of Maldives and several other dignitaries from various countries as well as stakeholders and discussed with them the solutions to several issues such as Climate Change, Plastic Pollution, Data Driven Environmental Solutions etc.
